





The use of open source software is fundamental to a sustainable and technologically independent development, says Rafael Martín Espada, Director General of ICT at the regional government of Extremadura.

"We have a long list of recommendations that we are willing to share with all administrations that are considering open source", Espada said on 29 November 2009 at a seminar in Brussels.

The region for instance advises to take fiscal measures to promote the creation of open source business. "Make its adoption a priority for public administrations. Use open source when you are organising electronic polls, stress its use in your development strategy and build demo centres to increase the trust in this type of software."

Espada said Extremadura's government will continue to push open source software as a tool to develop the region.

This year it has started centres for software excellence, where open source applications can be tested and certified. "Our GNU/Linex Excellence Centre is to become a point of reference for those companies that want to migrate their development to that platform."
