Cooperative Extension across the USA

- --> Exists in every state in the United States
- --> Outreach component of "Land Grant" Schools tasked with bringing university to the people
- --> Traditionally based on agriculture, but topics have expanded based on emerging needs
- --> Relies on need assessments and evaluations
- --> No exclusive support of one company allowed

- --> Natural Resources program team

- --> Original focus on natural resource professionals, teachers, planning boards




















Shift to emphasis on free / open source

- --> Needed a way to get people started with GIS






